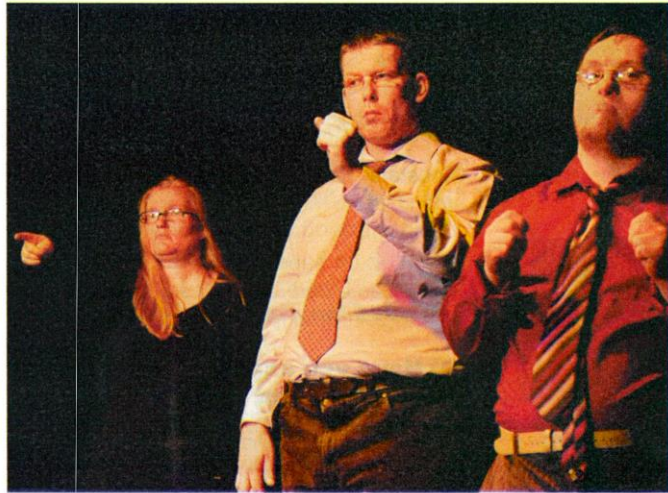


Welten-Brecher Theatre

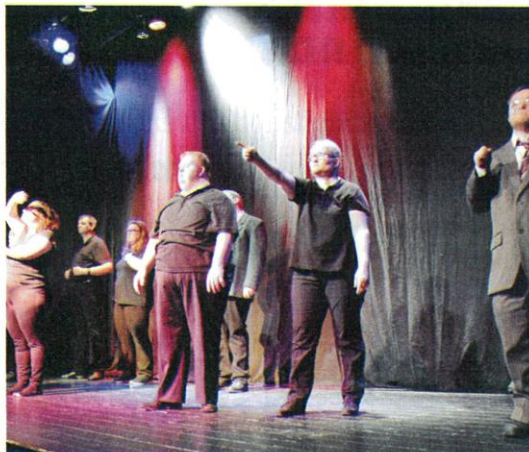


The actors of the ensemble work in various departments of the organization focused on helping people with disabilities and meet weekly to develop their play.
